  - Some services include advocacy, meditation, referrals, and service providers can receive technical assistance, direct referrals, and many other services.
  - They have had great success when filing grievances this year and they have noticed that they
    are getting reviewed consistently.
    - CS Gonzalez asked if they are having less outreach but seeing more clients?
      - a. Stephen answered that clients know his position since he has been working there for a while and the number of clients have remained relatively the same as pre-pandemic numbers. He does have a number of outreaches scheduled and thinks that previous outreaches may have helped.
