Minutes

1. Introductions and Welcome

The meeting was called to order at 3:02 pm by CM Adams and everyone introduced themselves. Quorum was established.

2. Review/Approve August 11th, 2026 DRAFT Agenda – VOTE

The August 11th, 2026 DRAFT Agenda was reviewed and approved by consensus.

6. HIV Care Connect Report – Flor Roman

- Flor Roman introduced the HIV Care Connect (HCC) report, noting that HCC has replaced the AIDS Regional Informational Evaluation System (ARIES), and this is the first year they are relying solely on data from HCC. Roman highlighted that this report is an analysis of the San Francisco Eligible Metropolitan Area (EMA) that includes data for all Ryan White parts, San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) HHS General Funds, and EHE funds for the 2025 calendar year. The presentation will review what HCC is and what it is used for. The report reviewed facts on the data reporting including reporting period, funding sources, dates of data, and total EMA unduplicated client count (UDC). The data shows a total EMA-wide UDC count of 6,139. The report will review EMA data including sex at birth, age, race, and current living situation. Roman discussed that the final presentation will also look at antiretroviral therapy (ART) and viral load data and data changes. Roman noted that they will discuss some of the data changes that have occurred recently and will review some general frequently asked questions.
 - CS Molnar asked about the age category for the EMA Viral Load by Age slide and asked if there is a way for them to further delineate the ages beyond just “age 65 & over”?
 - Roman noted that this is how HCC reports breakdown the ages of folks and they do not currently have the ability to further break down the ages.
 - CS Molnar asked if they saw much of a change in demographics when they switched from using gender to sex at birth?
 - Roman noted that last year’s data showed about 5% of folks identified as transgender and this year’s data shows sex at birth.

- CM Lee-Miyaki expressed concerns about the changes and expected pushbacks.
 - Beth Neary expanded upon why this change has been made and noted they are trying to be mindful of the current situation. She added that they would be able to provide supplemental verbal information and provide a separate handout with this demographic information.
- CM Le noted that the key for the age breakdown on the slide with Marin's data wasn't accurate.
 - Roman noted that she will review and update the information.

7. Service Summary Sheets Report – John Aynsley

- Beth Neary provided a brief overview of HHS Service Summary Sheets presentation and reviewed the previous years' service category order, budget information, support services, and core services. Neary noted that some of the demographic reporting may change and John Aynsley can review what changed when he does the presentation.
 - CM Lee-Miyaki asked if there is a way to further parse out the ages, as lumping all the elders into one category of "65+" is not very detailed.
 - CM Blum said he will ask Aynsley if he is able to further break down the ages but noted that it may be too much work to do.
 - CM Blum asked CS Molnar if this presentation is scheduled for August or September, as HHS was under the impression that this would be a September presentation.
 - CS Molnar confirmed that it is scheduled for August.
 - ❖ CM Blum asked if it would be possible to reschedule it for September.
 - CS Molnar confirmed that it will be pushed to September and will likely mean that August's Full Council meeting will be fairly short.
