7. HIV Care Megatrends

- CM Blum provides a verbal overview of the HIV Care Megatrends presentation. He highlights that last year the presentation reviewed viral suppression by population, and will include that in this year's presentation, which will help review where disparities in viral suppression are. He reviews that the presentation will cover local, state, and federal trends, as well as budgetary trends. He adds that he will review viral suppression by housing status, and some of the work they are doing for people who

are experiencing housing instability and homelessness. The presentation will also cover information related to the overdose crisis and the latest in terms of substance use. CM Blum will also review information related to HIV & aging. State-wide trends and the change in formula for Ryan White Part A and B will be reviewed. Additionally, the presentation will cover issues and trends in the professional pipeline, data integration, electronic medical record numbers, biomedical trends, and the latest in terms of what is happening in the field.
