Minutes

1. Introductions and Welcome

The meeting was called to order at 3:02 pm by CM Adams and everyone introduced themselves. Quorum was established.

- CM Blum shared that he met with the Mayor's Office and provided a general update about the meeting. He shared that it seems they want to hear about council members' motivations, connections, and reasons for wanting to be on the Council. He added that they did discuss civil disobedience and that it's not seen as a disqualification, but rather, they would like applicants to be open and forthcoming about any justice involvement during the interview process rather than the Mayor's Office finding out through a background check.
 - CM Le noted the requirement for both San Mateo County and Marin County appointed seats on the Council and asked, if they were to say no to their appointment, would that mean they don't need to serve on the Council?
 - CM Blum said that unless there are some shocking things that come up in the background checks, they should be fine. If for some reason they were not accepted, they would reach out and have that conversation.
 - CM Lee-Miyaki asked if these guidelines are posted anywhere and noted they should be for transparency purposes.
 - CM Blum noted that things have been different under this mayor, but that they are working to understand the process.

6. Prevention Megatrends

- CM Knoble reviewed last year's Prevention Megatrends presentation to discuss what will or should be included in this year's. They reviewed the agenda and what they hope to cover during the presentation. They will touch on the Ending the Epidemics (ETE) overview and pillars. changes they will be making to this year's presentation to make it current. CM Knoble asked the Committee for their thoughts on what they'd like to see or if there is anything missing.
