8. Resource Allocation- VOTE

- The Committee voted on resource allocation funding scenarios.
 - CS Cone noted that Council Affairs approved the following resource allocation funding scenarios, which are the same as last year. She went over the scenarios one by one.
 - o <u>Increased Funding</u>: If increased funding occurs, the council will reconvene to discuss this scenario.
 - CS Cone added that this scenario is quite unlikely, and that last year folks thought it'd be best for the Council to reconvene to discuss if this does happen.
 - Flat Funding: If funding remains at the current level, service category resource allocation will remain level across all categories.
 - CS Cone noted that this is the most unlikely of scenarios, because we'd have to receive the exact same funding to the dollar.
 - <u>Decreased Funding:</u> In the event of decreased funding, for the first 10% of reductions, allocations for services that are covered under California's essential health benefits package* will be reduced proportionately. If further reduced allocation is required, reductions will occur proportionately across all service categories.
