### 7. Demographic Information Update

- CS Perez shares the EPI demographic update and highlights that the only change is the total membership count, which is now at 29 council members.
- CS Perez shares the ARIES demographic update and highlights that the Council is still underrepresented for the Black/African American community, males, and youth.
  - CM Ron Hernandez asks about the Needs Assessment and COLA.
    - CS Perez says the Needs Assessment is currently underway and the target population is people living with HIV who are 65+ years old. She notes that the Community Engagement Committee is currently discussing a new COLA target population and will likely be selecting immigrants living with HIV.
  - CM Chitty asks if there's information on other councils that may have more success in attracting youth and if there is a way of contacting other councils?
    - CS Perez says other councils have similar issues around youth recruitment.
  - CM Soto adds that they're struggling on the state level to recruit youth, too. He asks if the Council is still involved in the Community Health Leadership Initiative (CHLI) mentorship program?
    - CS Perez says she will discuss with CS Molnar and report back.
  - CM Arnold asks what the youth age range is and if it's preferred that they be a consumer of services?
    - CS Perez says they are looking for youth who are 18-24 years old. She notes that being a consumer is a positive but not a necessity.
