8. HIV Budget to Advocacy– VOTE

- Bill Hirsch reviews HAPN HIV Budget Proposal:
 - Housing subsidies: 500,000
 - Mental health services: 3.6 mil
 - Overdose prevention(safe consumption sites): 1-2 million
 - Mental Health (Long-term survivors) services: 500,000
 - Intensive case Management: 500,000

Motion: CM Vasquez moves to approve these efforts

Second: CM Chitty seconds to approve these efforts
