## **Minutes**

#### 1. Introductions

The meeting was called to order at 3:07 pm by CS Molnar. Everyone introduced themselves and quorum was not established.

2. Review/Approve July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025 and June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025 DRAFT Agendas – VOTE

- 6. Committee and Work Group Reports VOTE
  - Community Engagement Committee Update
    - CS Perez updates the group that the Committee had their usual HCAP update and Stephen Spano circled back on a few cases they had been working on. The Committee also received a Needs Assessment update and discussed a new COLA target population.
  - Council Affairs Committee Update
    - CS Perez updates the group that the Committee reviewed the Prevention Megatrends presentation, noting that it was more of a discussion around what the council members wanted to see in the presentation.
  - Membership Committee Update
    - CM Ron Hernandez updates the group that the Committee reviewed a resignation from a council member and there were two Leaves of Absences that ended. He notes the Council is still underrepresented for the Black/African American community.

#### 7. Meeting Evaluation

CS Perez shares the results from the last Full Council meeting and the average rating was 9.7.

#### 8. Full Council Agenda

o CS Molnar shares and reviews the Full Council agenda for July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

## 9. By-laws and P&P Review - VOTE

- CS Molnar resumes reviewing the HCPC By-laws and P&P, starting with "Meeting Attendance." He notes that this had previously been reviewed, but CM Blum suggested an edit to this to add verbiage regarding the Membership Committee's ability to adjust policy regarding council members challenges with attendance on a case-by-case basis. CS Molnar proposes an addition, and the group discusses any changes.
  - CM Parada suggests adding language around the Membership Committee making "reasonable accommodations" for folks.
    - ♦ CM Blum suggests this phrasing isn't ideal as reasonable accommodations refer to particular accommodations.
- CS Molnar shares "Orientation & Training for New Council Members" and the group discusses any changes.
  - CM Blum suggests adding the role of the grantees to the Orientation list.
    - ♦ CS Molnar confirms it is on the list.
  - CM Blum asks if there is any information on the merge council that is presented during Orientation?
    - ♦ CS Molnar confirms it is on the list.
- o CS Molnar shares "Mentoring Program" and the group discusses any changes.
- o CS Molnar shares "Expense Reimbursement" and the group discusses any changes.
  - CM Blum says the current policy may not be doable and asks that it be put on hold until he can review it.
    - ♦ CS Molnar confirms he will send it to CM Blum to review.
- o CS Molnar shares "Conflict Resolution" and the group discusses any changes.
  - CM Blum asks if it makes sense to add to this policy to suggest that violence or the threat of violence will not be tolerated and may be grounds for removal from the Council. If so, he suggests adding specific verbiage around violence not being tolerated.
    - ◆ CS Molnar highlights that the policy outlines disruptive behavior is anything that violates the Council's core values. He agrees with CM Blum's suggestion and adds the requested verbiage.
- CS Molnar share "Corrective Action & Involuntary Removal" and the group discusses any changes.
  - CM Blum suggests noting that for "change of status and/or loss of affiliation which qualified the member for appointment" be changed to reflect that that would apply to those with federally mandated seats.
