- The committee reviewed the co-chair voting policy, specifically about whether the government cochairs should have a shared vote or not.
 - CS Molnar noted that pre-merge, the Prevention council had a government co-chair while the Care Council did not.
 - o CM Siron spoke to the equity of each person having a whole vote.
 - CS Molnar added the when the Prevention and Care government representatives share a vote, it means they are working together.
 - o CM Hernandez expressed support for the two government co-chairs working together.
 - CM Chitty spoke to the view of this as a position rather than individuals. Government has
 one vote, it's just split between two people. It would increase the impact of government
 on the council to give the government co-chairs two votes.
 - CS Molnar noted that at the merge of the council, there was discussion about which government representative should leave or stay. They settled on half votes so that both could stay.
 - o CM Flores sees both sides, and noted that if it's not broken why fix it.
 - o There were no motions on the floor, so the policy will stay as is.
- Public Comment: Jovon Bright spoke to his professional experiences in resolving conflict and coming to agreement on issues between different departments. He spoke to wanting to move together or not at all.
