1. Introductions

6. HCAP Report

- The Committee received the monthly update from the HIV Consumer Advocacy Project. (Stephen Spano)
 - o Stephen reported that the most notable trend this month was a slight uptick in dental services.
 - The group discussed the rest of the report including referrals, renewals, and building trustful relationships with clients while maintaining good boundaries.
 - CM Sutter clarified that one incident was a hate crime.
 - Stephen confirmed this and added that while the perpetrator wasn't a service provider, the victim could still access HCAP services.

7. COLA Update

- CS Clark updated the group on 2020 COLA planning:
 - o Council Staff is working with CM Nascimento to schedule a COLA in partnership with a Portuguese speaking support group. They are hoping to do the COLA later this month.

- The group reviewed the draft COLA survey and made minor changes.
 - o CM Matthews suggested asking the immigration question in the verbal part rather than on paper, in order to make it less potentially triggering.
 - CM Sullivan added that it should be asked at the end of the survey for the same reason.
 - Minor changes to the survey include a language question, sexual orientation and reflecting the SOJI guidelines around gender.
 - The conversational part can include a question around what brought folks to the U.S.

8. Needs Assessment - VOTE

- The Committee discussed the 2020 Needs Assessment and made updates to the survey, including:
 - SOJI guidelines
 - o Immigration status
 - Language capacity
 - What is your primary language(s)? (check all that apply)
 - Is language a barrier?
 - How many service providers have language capacity in your language? Are there adequate resources in the language you speak?
 - The verbal section may include questions around language capacity in terms of reading, writing and speaking.
- The group decided to table this conversation until next month.
