1. Introductions

7. COLA Update

• CS Jordan noted that before Shelter in place CM Nascimento was working on translating a survey for the Portuguese speaking COLA. This was scheduled for the end of March. All COLAs are temporarily on hold.

8. Needs Assessment

- CS Jordan discussed the challenges around this year's Needs Assessment given the current public health situation. He brought up the idea of a survey-only Needs Assessment.
- CS Jordan spoke to putting together a provider list of who we could collaborate with. We need to also
 figure out how to incentivize participants, even if the Needs Assessment is entirely online. He asked for
 feedback from the group.
 - o CM Jewell spoke to incentivizing participation.
 - o CM Cabangun spoke to not relying on Zoom, because not all clients necessarily have access to Zoom.
 - o CM Jordan spoke to making the data as consistent as possible.
- CM Nascimento added that for the Aguilas group he works with, they developed a survey with Google forms. Safeway gift cards could also be a good incentive right now.
